### **STAFF FIRE TRAINING**

Current legislation under the Fire Safety Reform Order 2005 requires employers to provide training to staff in the actions to be taken in the event of fire. To help you meet this requirement, we are pleased to offer comprehensive Fire Training courses.

Our course includes basic fire prevention measures, explanation of signage, means of escape, legislation, evacuation procedures and practical fire fighting techniques.

Fire Warden Training Courses – conducted by MCFP managing director Mike Chilman - are held regularly at our training centre in Bicester or at client premises. The format is as follows:

#### **Fire Warden Training Course**

##### **◆ Introduction**

Outline the aims and objectives of the course; i.e. fire fighting familiarisation

##### **◆ Understanding Fire principles**

The Fire current Fire Laws, understanding of the fire triangle, housekeeping in the workplace, ignition and spread of fire. Use of DVD to highlight importance of fire induction and general fire safety

##### **◆ Fire Risk Assessment**

Explanation of what a Fire Risk Assessment is and how to carry one out in the workplace. Group discussion about the company premises.

##### **◆ Portable Fire Extinguisher- Theory**

Classroom tutorial - The workings and selection of appropriate fire extinguishers. Different categories of fire and suitable types of fire extinguisher to use. DVD film

##### **◆ Portable Fire Extinguisher – Practical Demonstration Portable Fire Extinguisher**

Practical use of portable fire extinguishers outside in the car park or similar area. MCFP supply the fire extinguishers for discharging. It is our hope that all delegates use the extinguishers to get a real feel for how they work and how to use them.
